

# IORP ABRAXAS I

## Intensive Open Residential Program

The Intensive Open Residential Program (IORP) is a highly structured, staff-secure residential program on the Abraxas I campus. IORP provides individualized treatment for youth with diverse needs and uses a strengths-based approach, which focuses on intensive clinical programming, evidence-based curricula, and personal character development. The program is designed with targeted interventions to address the criminogenic needs of youth who have engaged in delinquent behavior and are at risk of long-term involvement in the juvenile justice system.

- Delinquent and/or dependent male youth between the ages of 13 to 18+
- Youth must be in at least 7th grade
- History of behaviors that put youth at risk for continued involvement in the juvenile justice system
- Minimum IQ of 70

## UTILIZING A COGNITIVE BEHAVIORAL MODEL, THE INTENSIVE OPEN RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM INCORPORATES

- UNARMED: Gun Violence Education Program
- Teen Anger Management Education (TAME)
- Forward Thinking Interactive Journaling® Series
- Responsible Living Skills Development (Casey Life Skills)
- Carey Guides
- Psycho-educational Groups

A combination of bachelor's level counselors and master's level therapists provide individual, group, and family sessions. Collectively, the treatment team develops individualized treatment plans which identify each youth's core treatment needs and clinical action steps to address them. A psychiatric evaluation is provided for each youth within 45 days of admission as part of the assessment and treatment planning process. Medication management is available through our contracted psychiatrist.

Outpatient trauma focused therapy is available (as deemed necessary).



## EDUCATION

Our on-grounds, privately licensed Arlene Lissner middle and high school offers students the opportunity to earn credits that can be transferred to the home school. Each student is assigned a guidance counselor who helps ensure proper academic planning and transition. The school provides a full range of Special Education services. Students are provided opportunities for credit recovery, they can earn their high school diploma, participate in GED prep and testing, participate in SAT prep and testing and enroll in online college courses (on a case-by-case basis). Interscholastic athletic opportunities are available through the school for Track & Field, the Abraxas/Brookville Co-op for football, and the Abraxas/Forest Area Co-op for Basketball.

## CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Abraxas I is affiliated with the Pennsylvania Academic, Career and Technical Training Alliance and is a provider of OVR (Office of Vocational Rehabilitation) services.



IORP (Intensive Open Residential Program) is a service of Abraxas I, licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Human Services and accredited by The Joint Commission.
