DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT

Treatment services are based on the ASAM level of care.

EMERGENCY PLACEMENT UNIT

The Emergency Placement Unit is designed for short-term placements. The goals of the program are to provide a safe, trauma-informed care setting where treatment needs can be identified and allow time to develop a coordinated longer-term plan to meet the needs of the youth. A diagnostic assessment will be completed by a licensed therapist. Based upon the client's individual needs identified in the diagnostic assessment, programming and treatment services may include but is not limited to the following:

- Diagnostic Assessment
- Individual and Group Therapy
- Casey Life Skills Assessment
- Crisis Intervention (as needed)
- Case Management
- Drug Screens / Lab Urinalysis
- Psychiatric Services
- Medical / Somatic Services
- Pharmacologic Management Services
- Personal Care Services

The Abraxas Ohio Treatment Program offers residential treatment services for male youth 12 to under 21 years of age. The program offers Drug and Alcohol Treatment, Problematic Sexual Behavior Treatment and an Emergency Placement Unit.

SPECIALIZED PROGRAMMING

Aggression Replacement Training® (ART) group curriculum is also utilized and is a multimodal psycho-educational intervention designed to alter the behavior of chronically aggressive adolescents and young children. The goal is to improve social skill competence, anger control, and moral reasoning.

New to Clinical Programming at Abraxas Ohio is the UNARMED Gun Violence Education Program. This 12-session group helps youth understand the impact of gun violence and learn how to make safer, more informed choice. UNARMED includes Pre/Post Test, Guided Group Sessions, Watch, Think & Share Video Series, Team Builder & Reflection Activities, and Assigned Homework.

FAMILY INVOLVEMENT & SUPPORT

At Abraxas, we believe that family involvement is key to a youth's successful reintegration after completing the program.

FAMILY VISITATION & THERAPY:

- Supervised visits and therapy sessions are scheduled by the youth counselor or therapist.
- Families are encouraged to attend bi-weekly family conferencing sessions, led by the youth's counselor, and guided by a licensed clinician.

ONGOING COMMUNICATION:

- The facility provides bi-weekly updates to families, and youth connect with their families weekly to discuss treatment progress.
- Phone and video conferencing options are available when in-person visits aren't possible.

TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT:

- Transportation assistance is available on a case-by-case basis to help families attend visits and sessions.

EDUCATION SERVICES

At Abraxas Ohio, we are committed to helping youth succeed academically while in our care. Our on-site, year-round educational services are provided through a partnership with the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center, which is fully accredited and licensed by the Ohio Department of Education.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:

- Credits earned are fully transferable to the youth's home school.
- Youth can pursue either a high school diploma or a GED.
- Special education services are provided in compliance with all legal requirements, including:
 - Individualized Education Programs (IEPs)
 - Evaluation Team Reports (ETRs)
 - 504 Plans

CREDIT RECOVERY & ACCELERATION:

- Options for independent study and credit flex programs are available.
- Students can complete coursework at their own pace to catch up or get ahead.

CERTIFICATIONS & POST-GRADUATE PREP:

- Students have access to real-world certifications, including:
 - CPR Certification
 - ServSafe® Food Safety Certification
- We support students in FAFSA completion, career exploration, and post-secondary planning.
- ACT and SAT prep and testing are available on-site

This education program is designed to empower students with the tools they need to succeed both in the classroom and beyond.

COMMUNITY REINTEGRATION

Abraxas partners with placing agencies and families to build strong community support systems, ensuring each youth has the resources they need to successfully return home.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

We provide multiple community service opportunities, both on and off campus, helping youth build empathy, responsibility, and a sense of purpose.
